

## Slate Path Footpath Slate Mulch

A **cost effective** solution for the **regeneration** of footpaths, access paths, bridleways and golf courses.

Slate Path is a **beautiful** natural plum colour that deepens in colour when wet. The finer <12mm grades of this material pack extremely well to provide an attractive and **easy to lay** alternative to traditional paving materials, suitable for footpaths and cycle paths.

# **Slate Path Footpath Slate Mulch** 0-12mm

Slate Path can be used in sensitive environments, such as woodland paths, tracks, or areas of ecological importance, where inert materials are a pre-requisite.

They will not affect the pH of the surrounding soils/habitats and provide an environmentally balanced alternative to the usual lime-based products.

### **Laying Method**

#### **Foundation**

Slate Path should be laid on a suitable free-draining sub-base such as **MOT type 3**. The design should include a camber to allow free drainage of surface water. We recommend that wooden gravel boards be used to retain the material.

#### **Spread**

Slate Path should be applied in layers and rolled using a vibrating roller to create a firm surface. Layers should be built up to a **recommended depth of 50mm**. In dry weather, it may be necessary to administer water to the material to improve binding.

#### **After Laying**

Slate Path requires minimal attention. Should rutting or potholes occur then cut out the affected area and relay following the guidelines above.
