



Slate Path Footpath Slate Mulch

A **cost effective** solution for the **regeneration** of footpaths, access paths, bridleways and golf courses.

Slate Path is a **beautiful** natural plum colour that deepens in colour when wet. The finer <12mm grades of this material pack extremely well to provide an attractive and **easy to lay** alternative to traditional paving materials, suitable for footpaths and cycle paths.

Slate Path can be used in **sensitive environments**, such as woodland paths, tracks, or areas of **ecological importance**, where inert materials are a pre-requisite. They will not affect the pH of the surrounding soils/habitats and provide an **environmentally balanced** alternative to the usual lime-based products.

Laying Method

Foundation

Slate Path should be laid on a suitable free-draining sub-base such as **MOT type 3**. The design should include a camber to allow free drainage of surface water. We recommend that wooden gravel boards be used to retain the material.

Spread

Slate Path should be applied in layers and rolled using a vibrating roller to create a firm surface. Layers should be built up to a **recommended depth of 50mm**. In dry weather, it may be necessary to administer water to the material to improve binding.

After Laying

Slate Path requires minimal attention. Should rutting or potholes occur then cut out the affected area and relay following the guidelines above.
